RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. INTRODUCTION

Sardar Patel Subharti Institute of Law and Integrated School of law (INMANTEC) cordially invites you to the 2nd All India National Moot Court Competition, to be held on **07-08 May 2022**.

2. ELIGIBILITY

All students who are either enrolled in a 3-year LLB programme or a 5-year integrated LLB programme shall be eligible to participate.

3. TEAM COMPOSITION

Each team shall consist of only two speakers and one researcher. The teams may choose to participate without a Researcher, and therefore with two speakers, one of them may choose to appear as researcher in Researcher Test as in case of tie, the marks of researcher test may be considered to come to a conclusion. The teams will be assigned Team Codes by the Organizers.

4. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official Language of the Competition, including all forms of Oral and Written Submissions, shall be in English.

5. REGISTRATION

In order to confirm participation, teams should register themselves. The teams must register on or before **12th April 2022**. Registration Fees: Rs 2700/- per team (Early Bird Registration).

If team registers themselves in between **13th April – 20th April 2022**, than registration fees is: Rs 3000/- per team. The registration fee can be paid through:

7. AWARDS

- Winners/Best Team – Trophy and Prize worth equivalent to Rs.86,100 including cash prize Rs.5100/- (for team)
- Runners up/Second - Best Team – Trophy and Prize worth equivalent to Rs.48,100 including cash prize Rs.3100/- (for team)
- Best Mooter (on the basis of the performance in Preliminary Round) - Trophy and cash prize Rs.1100
- Best Memorial - Trophy and cash prize Rs.1100
- Best Researcher - Trophy and cash prize Rs.1100
- All Participants shall be given Certificate of Participation, Kit & Memento.

9. MEMORIALS

I. General Rules

Each team shall be required to submit memorials for both the parties in doc. format. The soft copies are to be submitted on the following email address – **mootcourt.isl@inmantec.edu**

The deadline for submission of the softcopy of Memorials is **11.59 PM May 03, 2022**.

The organizers will not be responsible in case the email is not received before the deadline for any reason.

- While emailing the soft copies of the memorials, the subject of the email must be ‘Memorials for < Team Code>’. Both the files should be submitted through a single mail.
- The files sent, should be named as ‘Petitioner/Respondent – <Team Code>’
- The submissions that are received post the deadline will not be considered.
- Hard copy of the memorials should reach by **May 07, 2022** (on or before 8:30 am of **May 07, 2022** either by post or in person)
- Memorials submitted later than the given date will NOT be accepted by the organizers.
- The teams are required to submit 5 hard copies of the memorials of each party. The same shall be couriered/ post/ in person reach to the following address:

It is the responsibility of the teams to ensure that correct number of copies of the memorials is submitted and acknowledgement of the same is obtained from the organizers.

II. Format

The participating team is required to prepare a memorial for each party to the dispute with the following mandatory heads:

- i. Cover Page
- ii. Table of Contents
- iii. Index of Authorities
- iv. Statement of Jurisdiction
- v. Statement of Facts
- vi. Issues Raised
- vii. Summary of Arguments
- viii. Arguments Advanced
- ix. Prayer

- While citing authorities, the footnoting style to be followed is Harvard Bluebook 19th Ed.
- The teams must mention the Team Codes allotted to them in the emails sent for submission of the soft copies. Please note that the teams **SHALL NOT MENTION THE NAME OF THE PARTICIPANTS/ UNIVERSITIES/ INSTITUTIONS/ COLLEGES, OR ATTACH ANY NAME OR LOGO OF THE SAME.**
- All memorials shall conform to the following requirements failure of which will attract negative marking for the teams.
 - ❖ Memorials must be printed on A4 sheets and spiral bound.
 - ❖ The font of the body of the memorial should be in Times New Roman, font size 12, with 1.5 line spacing. The font size of the endnote/footnote if any must be in Times New Roman, font 10.
 - ❖ Each page must have a margin of at least one inch on all sides.
 - ❖ The total number of pages of memorials shall not exceed 25 typed pages for each party including the front page
 - ❖ The cover page should be printed in color (Blue for Petitioner , Red for Respondent)
 - ❖ The cover page **MUST** contain the Team Code in the upper right hand corner of the front page
 - ❖ All memorials received within time schedule will be evaluated by the **Memorial Evaluation Committee (MEC)** to be constituted by the Convener of the Moot Court Competition, Director- Integrated School of Law and Dean, SPSIL.

III. Oral Rounds

The Moot Court Competition shall comprise of the following rounds:

- In preliminary round, each team shall have to argue from both sides, that is, once for the applicant and once for the respondent.

- 4 highest scoring teams based on the marks of both side arguments will qualify for semi-finals.
- The semi-final round will be followed by final round with 2 teams.

IV. Scoring

- Memorial 20%
- Response to questions and articulation 20%
- Use of Authorities and Precedent 20%
- Reasoning in the Application of Principles 20%
- Application of Facts 10%
- Advocacy skills, Court Craft and Demeanor 10%

10. ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD

Accommodation to the participants will be on shared basis these facilities would be separate for girls and boys in the hostels at university campus. Accommodation facility would be made available from May 06th, 2022; 03:00 P.M. onwards till May 08, 2022; 6:00 P.M. Board and lodging shall be provided by the Organizers to the team members who avail accommodation facility .

The Moot Court Committee for the competition reserves the right to take appropriate action for any unethical, unprofessional, immoral conduct and uncalled for behavior of the participants at the competition venue and accommodation. If any situation arises which is not contemplated by the Rules, the decision of the Moot Court Committee shall remain final and binding. The Moot Court Committee reserves the right to vary, alter, modify and/or repeal any provision of the Rules if so required.
